

- A drawing compass. Many will have this tool but if you don't, here is a suggestion : [Click here for more information !](#)
- Circle template if you have one
- Triangles (450 and 300/600)

- Pointed pen
 - Suggestion is to use a pointed pen that you are familiar with and like to use
 - For those who are not familiar with the pointed pen I would suggest a Nikko G, Gillott 1068A or a Hunt 22
 - Point pen holder, whatever you are comfortable with (an oblique or straight holder)
 - Colors, I like to use the Pear Coliro Watercolors (the Bling) by Finetec

- Paper
 - Suggest Rhodia blank paper (which is white), this paper is great for the pointed pen and will use most inks without bleeding
 - Black paper, I use cardstock about 60 to 90 lbs

- Ink
 - Ink for white paper would be Sumi Black, Palace Moon or your favorite black ink.
 - Dr. Martin's Bleed Proof White for the black paper

- Brush
 - Using a brush as an applicator for the Finetec watercolors and Dr. Martin's Bleed Proof White

- Ruler

- Water
 - Need to have an eye dropper or a bottle to where you can just add a drop of water (distilled water)

- Liquid Gum Arabic
 - For the Dr. Martin's Bleed Proof ink

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
