

Recommended Workshop Supplies

- Any large transparent bottle (example: water jugs, vase)
- Brushes - Highly recommend using the FBP Brushes (beginner & advanced set found on bottlepainting.com) as they are made with soft synthetic bristles.
 - If you choose to get your own sizes. Here are the types and measurements. Please note that brushes from variety brands will not have exact sizes.
 - Stippler 3/8"
 - Stippler 3/16"
 - Flat 0.51"
 - Round 4/32"
 - Liner 0.8 mm
- Folk Art Multi-surface Acrylic Paint - specific colours we will be using for our project. Feel free to buy as many colours as your budget allows:
 - Wicker white
 - Vintage white
 - Steel grey
 - Pure black
 - Classic green
 - Blue peacock
 - Patina
 - Coffee Latte
- Deco Art Dura Clear Sealer - Matte or Gloss varnish
- Separate large flat paint brush or sponge brush to apply the sealer
- Rubbing alcohol and cotton pad (to clean bottle surface)
- Paper towel
- Brush rinse cup filled with water
- Palette or any mixing surface (disposable paper plate works well)
- Small fan (to increase dry time)
