## **Recommended Workshop Supplies**

- Mechanical Pencil (0.3 or 0.5) and / or wooden pencil with H or HB lead and a white eraser
- Ruler-see-thru plastic ruler or for ruling lines
- A couple of good quality small round pointed watercolor brushes (Winsor Newton Series 7 or similar, sizes 0, 1 or 2
- Tubes of gouache in black, white and several colors you like. A few Fine Tec Coliro metallic watercolors if you have them
- Palette with several small wells
- Paper A sheet of tracing paper. A few sheets of bond paper for sketching ideas. A sheet or two of mid weight drawing paper, like Strathmore series 400 drawing paper, for pencil work. A couple of small pieces of heavier (90#) hot press watercolor paper such as Arches HP, Fabriano Artistico or Rives BFK
- A clean, cheap bristle brush, 1" or 2"
- Words/Texts that have meaning to you. A two to four word text
- Writing board (piece of Masonite or similar, with a few sheets of paper taped to it for padding) to work on that can be propped at a low slant and something to prop it with
- Usual supplies: Water containers, paper towels, notebook for notes, masking tape
